The Study of Early Years Education and Development

A new study is being launched involving 8,000 families across England. The study has been commissioned by the DfE and is to be carried out by NatCen Social Research, Frontier Economics, the University of Oxford and 4Children. It is a longitudinal study called 'The Study of Early Years Education and Development' (SEED) and will follow 8,000 2 year olds through to the end of key stage 1.

The study will involve interviewing families in the homes and visiting 1,000 settings and you need to be aware that you may be contacted directly to take part in the study.
